“Who is a God like you, pardoning iniquity and passing over transgression for the remnant of his inheritance? He does not retain his anger forever, because he delights in steadfast love.

He will again have compassion on us; he will tread our iniquities underfoot. You will cast all our sins into the depths of the sea.”

Micah 7: 18-19

The verses above illustrate what God does to our since through Jesus’ finished work on the cross.

After reading this, are there any areas of your life where you still feel trapped and condemned in sin? What are they?

Romans 8: 1-4 tells us the effect of Jesus’ finished work on the cross.

“There is therefore no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus. For the law of the Spirit of life has set you free in Christ Jesus from the law of sin and death. (1-2)

In Christ, we are now set free from any condemnation or trap of sin in our lives.

How? Let’s look at verse 3...

For God has done what the law, weakened by the flesh, could not do. By sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh and for sin, he condemned sin in the flesh,... (3)

Jesus, the Son of God, came down from heaven to die for our sins. But because he has never committed sin, he was able to condemn and win again sin in his human form. Jesus Christ’s sinless nature allowed him—and we who share in his death and resurrection—to resurrect from the death and enter into life eternal.

In applying this to our lives, we can walk according to the Holy spirit in us, reconciled, holy, and blameless before God the Father, because of Jesus Christ.

in order that the righteous requirement of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not according to flesh but according to the Spirit.” (4)

How can you apply this truth everyday in terms of what you think, what you say, and what you do?
